### Celebrating Milestones and Advancements

We are thrilled to share some exciting updates and achievements from the Electrical Training Institute as we continue strengthening our commitment to providing top-notch education and fostering a diverse and inclusive learning environment.

#### **Surge in Apprentice Class Numbers**

We are excited to report that our apprentice class numbers are at an all-time high, with over **750** registered apprentices attending classes. This speaks volumes about the recognition of our programs' value to aspiring professionals in our industry. With the prospect of even more demand for trained electrical workers in the near future, we are continually improving, researching, and collaborating to meet the industry's needs.





#### **Building an Inclusive Learning Community**

Embracing diversity is a core principle at the ETI. We are proud to announce that the number of women and minorities in our programs has reached unprecedented levels. Notably, our female application numbers are up over **315**% from 2022, and minority applications are up over **65**% from 2022. This reflects the inclusivity of our community and the increasing interest and demand for quality education across diverse demographics.

#### **Technological Advances in Online Curriculum Delivery**

In response to the evolving education landscape, we have integrated cutting-edge technology into our online curriculum delivery. Our commitment to staying ahead of the curve ensures that our students receive the most relevant and up-to-date training, setting them apart in their respective fields. We have focused on creating video content to supplement our apprentice learning outside of school. Our students overwhelmingly embrace this added resource and collectively spent over **2,390** hours studying video content in addition to classroom instruction.

#### Open House and Back to School Nights

To enhance our exposure in the community, we hosted an open house in July, featuring prizes and reducing the application fee to \$0. We also held an open house which allowed current students to bring their friends and family to the ETI. Over 600 attendees visited our training center over the course of two evenings. The overall impact of these two events was even greater than we anticipated as we took in over 250 applications! We are glad to report that several applicants have been selected for the January 2024 class and are working on job sites.

#### **Grant Recognition for Cutting-Edge Instruction**

We are thrilled to announce that the ETI has been awarded grant money in excess of \$150,000 in recognition of our cutting-edge instruction. These monies are being invested in electric vehicle infrastructure training, a new state-of-the-art programmable logic controllers laboratory, and an updated testing center and computer lab. By working with our educational partners, we are committed to providing innovative and effective educational solutions that prepare our students for success in the electrical industry.





#### **Engaging Retirees as Instructors and Mentors**

Recognizing the wealth of knowledge and experience retirees bring, we have engaged retirees as instructors and mentors for our students. Their industry insights and mentorship contribute significantly to the development of our learners. We enlisted the help of 4 retirees this semester to teach introductory circuitry courses and administer our entrance aptitude test.
